The General Body Meeting of the Parent Teacher Association was conducted on Saturday 07<sup>th</sup> August 2021. Notice for the same was sent on Top School on 24/07/2021. The meeting commenced at 1:30 pm.

**Point No. 1] Welcome:**

Principal Ms. Sumedha Phadke introduced herself and welcomed the parents.

The agenda for the meeting was shared with the parents.

**Point No. 2] Vision and Mission:**

The school's vision and mission were shared with the parents. We believe that every child is unique and the school provides a facilitative, challenging and positive environment for the overall development of the child.

**Point No. 3] Yearly Planner:**

The school is well organized and planned in its structure. It was shared that the school planner is shared on the school website along with the holiday list. Additionally, it is also uploaded in the General Teams of all the classes for the convenience of the students and the parents.

**Point No. 4] Achievement**

The results of Class X and XII of City Pride School Nigdi and City Pride Junior College, Nigdi were shared with the parents.

**Point No. 5] Announcement of EPTA members:**

It was shared with the parents that according to the Maharashtra Educational Institutions (Regulation of Fee) Act 2011 and Rules 2016, the PTA for academic year 2021-22 was formed. All the parents are members of PTA. An annual amount of Rs. 50 will be collected from each member of the PTA. The EPTA is to be formed within 30 days from reopening of school in an academic year. She further mentioned that The General Body of Parent Teacher association was formed on 19th of June. A note for the same was circulated to all the parents. Along with self-nomination form for Executive body formation was sent to all the parents of standard I to III via top-school. In case of more than 1 parent nominating from a particular standard a lucky draw was scheduled to be conducted. 27 parents submitted their willingness for E-PTA. Subsequently, an online lucky draw was conducted and the required number of members were elected.

The list of E-PTA members was shared with the parents. It was told that is also available on the school's website. The class wise fee structure was shared with the parents.

**Point No. 6,7] Online Teaching – Scholastic and Co- Scholastic:** She mentioned that the school began in an online mode and the teaching learning process was successfully in progress on MS Teams platform. Some glimpses of the online teaching-learning were shared with the parents. City Pride school follows a specific homework time table along with the class time table which was shared with the parents.

City Pride School conducts some additional activities like:



**Intelligence (I-cube):** Intelligence is formulated with a vision of taking quantitative analysis, problem solving, logical, analytical and abstract reasoning. This encourages the development of brain and use of intuition and innovation. It gives lot of flexibility, fun and self-confidence which will help in overall personality development which will help to shine not only in the classroom but towards the brightest career

**Discovery:** A unique Enquiry Based Learning concept to develop scientific temperament and curiosity in young learners. The students of class III are given the files, worksheets and kits for Discovery activities. In case any parent has not collected it, they were asked to collect it from the school office.

**Physical Education, DMK and Arts:** It was shared that physical education which constitutes Yoga, warm up activities, Zumba and aerobics was conducted in the regular time table. It was also told that at the entry level a google form is sent to the parents to choose on of the DMK activity: dance, music or keyboard. Accordingly, teams were created and students are provided with online training in these cocurricular subjects as part of the regular school even in the online mode. Also, we have regular art education period in our time table. The principal expressed her satisfaction over the conduct of these activities.

**Competitive Exams:** Information about the competitive exams was given to the parents. The school believes in appearing for these exams from Grade III. A detailed note for the registration process and other information was sent to the parents of standard III in the month of July.

**Intra School Competition:** It was shared that the Intra School Competition will be conducted online or offline depending on the pandemic situation. Certificates and trophies will be given to the winner after the competition on later dates following all the covid 19 safety measures.

**Point No. 8] Field Visits:** The parents were briefed about the online field visits for the academic year 2021-22. The dates are mentioned in the planner as well. The glimpses of the first field visit of different classes conducted on 24<sup>th</sup> July were shared with the parents.

**Point No. 9] Social Connect:** City Pride School believes in giving back to the society. It nurtures a feeling of empathy and well being and does its bit for the well being of the deserving sections of the society who cannot get certain privileges. Keeping in mind this philosophy, City Pride School Ravet has collaborated with Masti ki Pathshala Ravet (an NGO run school for construction site workers children). The children come to City Pride School Ravet campus for 2 days a week. Activity based learning curriculum is developed for these children. It is a great sense of satisfaction for the school as well as those children. Glimpses of the same were shared with the parents.

**Point No. 10] How do we communicate:** The parents were oriented with the process and various modes of communication between the parents and the school – Class Wise Orientation Meetings held in April before the reopening, Interaction Day, Open day, parents General body meeting, MS Teams, Top School, Whatsapp Groups. In addition, it was shared



that, the school conducts chit chat sessions in the afternoon on 1 particular day for each child. These are informal talks within the peer groups to facilitate sharing, social connect and caring in the pandemic times. The Principal expressed her delight over the conduct of these sessions and the happiness that it brings to the students.

**Point No. 10] Evaluation:** The Evaluation pattern, distribution of marks and the mode and means of the conduct of examination was shared with the parents. In general, the school conducts 4 examinations in a year: 2 periodic tests, term end exam and annual exam. Apart from this there are art integration activities, subject enrichment activities and Art Integration project conducted as per the academic plan. Examples of these activities were given to the parents.

The Principal introduced Management Representative Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni Madam and told the parents that the platform was open for Questions which would be answered by us.
